President Stephen McCall called the meeting to order at 1:18 pm.

Guests present: Bill Narducci, Union County Engineer's Office; Judy Christian, York Township; Fred Vogel, Jobs & Commerce, ODOT District 7 & 10; Brad Bodenmiller, Rebecca Longsmith and Heather Martin of LUC Regional Planning Commission.

Minutes – Scott Coleman moved a motion to approve the minutes from the April 14, 2016 meeting as written and Dave Faulkner seconded. All in favor.

Financial Report – Andy Yoder presented the Financial Report for April. Charles Hall moved a motion to accept the Financial Report and Scott Coleman seconded. All in favor.

ODOT Reports: Steve Shepherd reported things are the same for this month. Matt Parrill reported there would be a public meeting regarding bridge work on State Route 235. The meeting will be held at the Moose Lodge at Chippewa Park on June 16 from 4-6 pm. ODOT would like a lot of participation and public opinion. Matt will send the invitation and it will be placed on LUC's web-site. Scott Coleman asked about the paving on Route 33, Matt said he could get more details on it. Steve McCall asked about two projects on State Route 560, they're each 45-day closures; it's not posted as a 90-day closure, it's posted as a 45-day closure and he's received some calls. Matt reported that it is truly a 45-day structure and their office could field the calls.

 - Vince Papsidero moved a motion to accept Staff and Zoning and Subdivision Committee's recommendations to approve the Jerome Township Zoning Amendment with modifications and Charles Hall seconded. All in favor.
- 3. Building Committee Dave Gulden
 - O Dave Gulden provided an update regarding the work with TRC and Honda on a potential office space. Honda has allowed TRC to work directly with LUC. On Monday, Thayne Gray, Union County Assistant Prosecutor, and I met with TRC to work towards a lease. TRC is moving forward with an architect. I am going to meet with LUC Building Committee today.
 - Steve McCall Things are moving, as well as, the timeframe won't be as soon as we like it.
 - Dave Faulkner The other tenant's not in the mix anymore?
 - Dave Gulden They are; they just haven't signed any paperwork.
 They would be on one side; LUC would be on the other side with the largest conference room in between.

Director's Report:

 In addition to updating the Executive Committee, Dave Gulden introduced new LUC staff member Rebecca Longsmith who is working on the RTPO transportation planning.

Comments from Individuals:

• Steve McCall – As one of the duties of President, I want to make sure I'm involved and following up. An outstanding item is our Subdivision Regulations update. I'd like to see some movement on that. I'm pleased with the direction and leadership going on.
